

- o CHCA is sponsoring a street improvement project for school bus stops at S. Courthouse and S. 12th Street.
- o CHCA has successfully negotiated: a \$400,000 street light project on Barton Street between Columbia Pike and 16th Street; a \$360,000 street improvement project on 11th Street between Edgewood and S. Cleveland; and a \$350,00 park enhancement project at Walter Reed Park that built the fence between the community center and adjacent apartments, and the new entryways into the Park.

- o CHCA has participated in the Form Based Code group.
