

What we've been working on

AT A GLANCE

- The County Parks & Rec staff approved our request to install additional fencing along the side of the Walter Reed playground that faces the parking lot as an additional safety precaution. They have also agreed to add a protective film cover and/or warning signs for the metal drums installation that become very hot in the summer, & ensure that the rock-rope play structure is adequately maintained to ensure continued usability.
- Collaborating with CPRO to create a memorandum of understanding with the landlord & tenant of the Walgreens property to ensure the exterior is better maintained (landscaping maintenance & free of trash).
- Writing the County Board to request that they re-conduct a traffic study along S Edgewood St. between Columbia Pike & 13th Rd. S: requesting a 4 way stop at 11th St. S & better visibility at 12th St. S at S Edgewood St. & Walter Reed Dr.
- Joining forces with the Pike's Presidents Group to oppose the County Staff's proposed changes to the existing neighborhood form based code (NFBC) that would potentially allow for significant up-zoning & renter displacement along the eastern end of Columbia Pike.
- On the East side at the corner of 12th Street S & S Scott Street, pedestrian improvements are coming to include more clearly labeled crosswalks and improved sidewalks with room for students to wait for pick up by one of the many busses that pass through the neighborhood. This project will dovetail nicely with the opening of the connector roads to S Rolfe Streets allowing the elementary aged children to finally walk to Hoffman-Boston Elementary school. Previously busses picked up almost 150 elementary students from the neighborhood because of the lack of safe connection to the school.
